



Dr. Anna K. Kucharska is a senior research fellow at the Centre for Mathematical Modelling of Infectious Diseases, Imperial College London. She is also a senior research advisor at the UK Health Security Agency. Dr. Kucharska is a leading expert in the use of mathematical models to understand the spread of infectious diseases and to evaluate the impact of different control measures. She has been instrumental in the development of the UK's COVID-19 response, including the use of models to inform the decision to implement a national lockdown. Dr. Kucharska is also a member of the Scientific Advisory Group for England (SAGE) and has been involved in a number of other public health initiatives.
